



### Mosaic Veneer

Mosaic stone veneer is irregularly shaped with no definite pattern.




### Roughly Squared & Rectangular Veneer

Roughly squared and rectangular stone veneer is cut by guillotines to an angular style but is not intentionally cut to be exact 90° squares and rectangles.



### Ashlar Veneer

Ashlar stone veneer is guillotined or selected to be rectangular in shape. The stone is set wider than it is tall and set in a broken, running bond pattern.



### Ledgerstone

Rectangular strips of stone similar to ashlar veneer but generally smaller heights, approximately 1" to 3", depending on the stone. It creates a more linear appearance.

\* Not all stones are available in all cuts

**Full Veneer:** Thickness +3" to +- 6"

Coverage approximately 30 sq.ft. per ton depending on joint and cut

**Thin Veneer:** Thickness +- 3/4" to +- 1-1/2"

Coverage approximately 14 to 15 lbs. per sqft
